Responsibilities & Duties

- Evaluate the leisure and recreation needs of the child/youth with a disability and the assistance they require in order to participate in community leisure and recreation opportunities.
- Provide assistance to children with disabilities, while they pursue their leisure and recreation interests, including assisting with all aspects of the participant's personal care (washroom, feeding, dressing) if required).
- Encourage relationship building by facilitating the inclusion of the participant with their non-disabled peers.
- Utilize a collaborative approach towards inclusion by consulting with appropriate parties (the family, the program leaders and staff).
- Facilitate positive social interaction and relationship building of participant and fellow program campers.

- Candidates MUST be available to work all weeks.
- Candidates MUST meet the Canada Summer Jobs Grant eligibility: Youth aged 15-30 years who are full-time students (min 3 courses) intending to return to their studies in the next school year.

- Preference given to applicants with medical training, enrolled in nursing, recreation therapy or related field.

Skills

- Experience and/or knowledge supporting children, particularly those with disabilities.
- Excellent problem solving and collaboration skills.
- Versatility to work independently but also as an interactive team member.
- Experience supporting children with Autism is a strong asset
- Experience encouraging children in positive social interaction
