### Halifax Regional Municipality seeking applicants for internship program

Tuesday, May 7, 2019 (Halifax, NS) – The Halifax Regional Municipality is seeking applicants for 14 paid internships as part of its *Bridging the Gap* program.

The Bridging the Gap program has offered 102 graduates up to 18 months of paid internship with various business units of the municipality since 2013.

The program is designed to provide recent graduates opportunities to work in a municipal government structure, with exposure to government policy, program operations, administration and finance. Interns gain experience in their field and increase their chances of finding future employment in Nova Scotia.

In order to be eligible for the program, candidates must:

- Have a post-secondary education at the university or community college level
- Have graduated within 36 months
- Be legally entitled to work in Canada for the length of the term
- Meet the minimum qualification of the position
- Be a resident of Nova Scotia or attended a Nova Scotia university or college, with a strong interest in seeking employment in Halifax preferred
