- Responsible for the active supervision and interaction of children enrolled;
- Use of appropriate behavior guidance techniques;
- Establish and maintain effective communication with children, staff, parents, Inclusion Coordinator, and the Director;
- Mentor new ECE's, students and volunteers to ensure that they are supported;
- Responsible to maintain a clean and healthy classroom environment including toys and equipment as per Daycare Regulations;
- Responsible for implementation of the Centre's inclusion philosophy;
- Willingness to work with children of all ages;
- Accurately complete daily attendance sheets and ensure each child is signed in and signed out appropriately; and
- Complete professional development requirements as per the NS Classification for ECE's.

- Must hold a NS Classification in Early Childhood Education level 2 or 3;
- Experience working with children ages 3 months-5 years in a licensed child care facility;
- Experience working with parents and as part of a team in a licensed child care facility;
